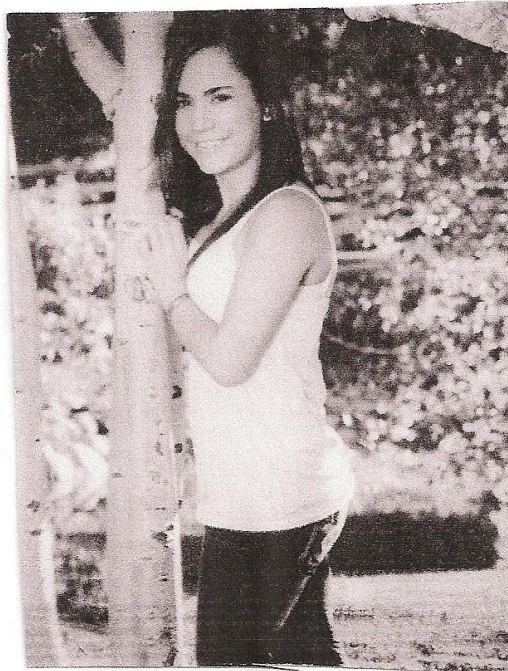
Dear RHS Alumni Association Scholarship,
