AROUND THE RHS CAMPUS

- 1. "WE THE PEOPLE" placed 14th in the Nation out of 56 teams.
- 2. Government teacher Richard Clark earned the Channel 4 Excellence in Education Class Act Award.
- 3. Student Leadership earned the NIAA top academic award.
- 4. **Kyra Hunsberger** (7 varsity letters) and **Connor Pearson** (6 varsity letters) were named RGJ and NIAA top student athletes for Northern Nevada.
- 5. Sophomore **Regan Caufield** is the best high school diver in the area.
- 6. Reno High was rated in the top 10 public schools in Nevada according to US News & World Report. The annual ratings are determined by performances of both traditional and disadvantaged students, graduation rates, and preparation for college.
- 7. **Brandon Kaho** is one of the most sought after football players in Northern Nevada as he has had 17 major college football programs seriously recruiting him.
- 8. **Samantha Puzey**, Class of 2009 and RHS Softball Coach, has been selected as Northern Nevada 4A coach of the year.
- 9. Junior **Mikayla Shults** was named Northern Nevada Female Athlete of the Year. She competed and excelled in cross country, basketball and track.
- 10. **Andrew Berreyesa** was named to the ASICA All-American list for wrestling and recognized as the National High School Coaches Association *Win Magazine* as the Nevada High School Wrestler of the Year.
- 11. Class of 2017 Statistics: 338 graduates, 125 Honors diplomas, 2 National Merit Finalists, 7 students maintained a 4.0 or above GPA for all four years, and 21 students have perfect attendance. RHS won 8 regional championships and 6 NIAA All-Academic honors. The school won the NIAA Award of Excellence which was rated for its achievement, sportsmanship and academics. Graduates earned over \$4 million dollars in scholarship monies.

ALUMNI NEWS

- 1. **Amber Pierce (Rais),** Class of 1999, was a standout swimmer at Reno High, setting state and national records. She received a swimming scholarship to Stanford University, but a shoulder injury derailed her swimming career. She instead turned to bicycle racing. Amber is on a cycling team that is based in the United States, which includes riders from around the world.
- 2. **Donald Carano**, Class of 1949, along with Ty Cobb, was honored at the UNR graduation ceremonies. He graduated from the University of San Francisco (USF), served two years in the U.S. Army as an officer, and graduated with honors from the USF Law School. Donald was a gaming pioneer who built the Eldorado Hotel and Casino in 1973 and created the Silver Legacy Resort Casino in 1992. He and his wife, Rhonda, founded the acclaimed Ferrari Carano Vineyards and Winery in Sonoma County.
- 3. **Leo Longobardo,** Reno High drivers education and history teacher from 1957 1985 passed away recently. He also coached football and baseball. After retiring, he became "the voice of the Reno High Huskies" announcing football games.
- 4. Former RHS basketball coach (1961-1987), **Ken Fujii**, conducted his 36th annual basketball camp at Reno High in June. RGJ stated that Fujii is one of the great high school basketball coaches in Nevada history.
- 5. The RGJ recently listed the top 100 local sports figures of 2016-17 that include eight former and current athletes from Reno High. Those mentioned were John Savage (UCLA baseball coach), Michael Weise (swimming), Christian Chamberlain (baseball), Mikayla Shults (cross country, basketball and track), Erika Root (distance runner), Brandon Kaho (football), Andrew Berreyesa (wrestling) and Joey Lavallee (wrestling).
- 6. Columnist **Karl Breckenridge**, Class of 1959, is no longer writing his weekly column on local history for the RGJ. You can find his past columns on RGJ.com.
- 7. The Founder of the National Security Forum, **Dr. Ty Cobb**, Class of 1958, was honored as the Distinguished Nevadan by the Nevada System of Higher Education.
- 8. Our condolences go out to the Dick Trachok family (RHS teacher and football coach from 1950-1959) in the death of his wife, Fran.

CLASSIC CARS FOR THE 2017 ALL-CLASS REUNION


